The 1732 Wade Bridge at Whitebridge is judged to be the finest surviving example of a typical long span arch bridge built during General Wade's road-building era.

The bridge was closed by Highland Council in 2007 after a consultant's report deemed it dangerous, though since unofficially reopened after first aid repairs in 2010 of the foundations to improve resilience to flood erosion. Our Trust was established in 2009 to safeguard the bridge and to apply for repair funds from organisations such as Stratherrick and Foyers Community Trust and Historic Environment Scotland. For this purpose we need to demonstrate wide support from the local community and from representatives of local organisations, as well as other interested individuals and groups.
