The 1732 Wade Bridge at Whitebridge is the finest surviving example of a typical long span arch bridge built during General Wade's road-building era. It was bypassed as a road bridge in 1925, and is used by pedestrians crossing the River Foyers to reach the eastern Highland Wildside Lodges. It is a popular feature on the Loch Ness 360 Trail.

The bridge was closed by Highland Council in 2007 after a report deemed it dangerous, and re-opened after first aid repairs in 2010 to improve resilience of the abutments to flood erosion. Our Trust was established to safeguard the bridge and to apply for much-needed repair funds from organisations such as Stratherrick and Foyers Community Trust and Historic Environment Scotland. We need to show wide support from the local community and from local organisations, as well as other interested individuals and groups.
